



COOPERATION AGREEMENT

between

LAPPEENRANTA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, FINLAND

and

UNIVERSIDAD DE CONCEPCION, CHILE

Universidad de Concepción, Chile, and Lappeenranta University of Technology, Finland, wish to build their partnership and develop academic collaborative working on a sustaining and mutual beneficial basis. To achieve these benefits, the universities agree on the following understandings:

Both universities agree to promote faculty and student programmes between their institutions for educational and research purposes. Such programmes may include:

- Exchange of faculty members and students in accordance with requirements accepted by both universities.
- Exchange of information about scientific achievements, important conferences and symposia as well as scientific publications in the field of mutual interest.
- Joint research in the fields of mutual interest in accordance with available funds and joint publications of the results of this research.

Terms of specific exchange or programme arrangements making any financial or legal commitment shall be discussed and memorialized in writing in advance, and signed by both parties.

The agreement becomes valid immediately upon signing it by officials representing the two universities. It shall remain in effect for a period of five years unless modified or revoked.

Either party may review the agreement and make suggestions for modification at any time. They are moved in a written form and become valid only after signing them by officials of both parties. In addition, either party may terminate his agreement on six months prior written notice to the other.
